Section 42-1-11.3 - Treatment of pregnant woman or woman who is in immediate postpartum period (a) As used in this Code section, the term: (1) 'Custodian' means warden, sheriff, jailer, deputy sheriff, police officer, or any other law enforcement officer. (2) 'Immediate postpartum period' means the six-week period following childbirth unless extended by a physician due to complications.

Section 42-1-11.3 - Treatment of pregnant woman or woman ...

(Postpartum hemorrhage often results in anemia, and iron therapy may need to be initiated. Exhaustion is common after hemorrhage. It may take the new mother weeks to feel like herself again. Fatigue may interfere with normal parent-infant bonding and attachment processes. The mother is likely to require assistance with housework and infant care.
