To create the desired partition layout when installing Linux Mint, switch the installer's page to "something else": It will show you the partitions on your hard drive. Mine has no partitions: Press the "+" button to add a new partition.

If you are looking to create separate partitions (which would be best), then you would need to create the partitions manually. In the example below Linux Mint 14 Cinnamon is used.

To manually partition a blank disk, boot from a live installation media and move to the installation type window and select something else. Now click on Continue to move to the next screen. See in the image below /dev/sda is the empty hard disk that we are going to partition.
